Clay Smith enters his 7th season as the head coach of the Wolfpack baseball team.



Smith served 10 years as associate head coach and recruiting coordinator at Belhaven University. While at Belhaven, Smith has coached five NAIA All-Americans, 27 All-Southern States Athletic Conference players as well as the 2007 Boo Ferris Award Finalist, Thomas Royals and 2009 Boo Ferris Award Winner Craig Westcott. Since 2004, the Blazers have won six Southern States Athletic Conference championships (2004, 2006, 2007, 2009, 2010, 2011), made seven appearances in NAIA post-season tournaments, and played in the 2010 NAIA World Series. The Blazers have averaged 38 wins a season and had six 40+-win seasons. Five former Blazers have been drafted in the Major League Baseball Draft, and 12 have signed professional contracts.

Prior to his coaching stint at Belhaven, Smith was an assistant baseball coach at the University of Southern Mississippi (2000-2002) where he coached five All-Conference USA players and three freshmen All-Americans.
